Thank you for supporting our scholarship ministry by playing in the Fourth Annual Barbara Bolton Memorial Golf Tournament.

- 1. USGA rules are always in effect. If a question comes up and you are not sure what to do, play two balls and write the score down for each. A rules determination will be made by the Head pro at the end of play.
- 2. The tournament is a two person scramble team format.
  - a. Each two person team tries to score the lowest score for the 18 holes.
  - b. After each person of the two person team has hit their tee shots, the team selects the ball in the best position and all second shots are placed and played within one club length of that selected ball. (No nearer the hole)
  - c. This is repeated until the hole is completed or you reach your BOGEY shot or putt.
  - d. For every shot you can lift, clean, and place your selected ball.
  - e. Wherever the selected ball lies, all shots must be taken from the same area condition. For example: Fairway on fairway. Rough in rough. Hazard in hazard.
  - f. When on the putting green, all balls must be placed no further than 4 inches from the selected ball, (no nearer the hole).
- 3. We will be using a **BOGEY** max score. When you reach **BOGEY**, please pick up, and continue to the next hole.
- 4. Out of bounds is marked by white stakes. Hazards are marked by red or yellow stakes.
  - a. Right of number 1 fairway designated driving range grounds is out bounds. Also right of #3, 4, 5, 6, & 10 is out of bounds.
- 5. Mulligans may be purchased before play begins.
  - a. Each two person team may purchase 4 mulligans.
  - b. Only one mulligan may be used on a single hole.
  - c. Mulligans may **NOT** be used for competition holes (closest to the pin or longest drive)
- 6. Scoring and score card Please review the following rules that deal with scoring and scorecards.
  - a. Download the Golf League Site app.
  - b. Return score cards first to the check in table.
  - c. All ties will be broken by the back nine score. If that doesn't break the tie it will be broken by the front nine score. If the tie still not broken, then we will work backwards on scorecard starting at hole 18.
