Welcome to the 2024 Laytonsville Tuesday League

This is a single player with handicap match play format. Players will play weekly matches against different players. For new players, your system handicap will be used. If you do not have an established handicap, you need to sign up in the proshop, and enter your previous scores to establish a baseline number. The number will be divided by 2 to represent a 9 hole handicap. You will start on day one with that handicap. Based on your performance, the system will adjust your handicap during the season. For returning players, your handicap will be carried over from last year's season.

The minimum handicap a player can have is 0
The maximum handicap a player can have is 10
Matches will be played each week based on each players established handicaps. A player cannot receive more than 6 strokes in a match.

Example 2 handicapper vs a 10 handicapper, The 10 will receive 6 strokes for the match

Laytonsville has a different slope rating on each 9. The back 9 is more difficult so the handicaps will be different on the back 9. The adjustments will be the same for all players.

Players will compete their matches on the front and back 9 in alternating weeks.

The score card will indicate the stroke holes a player will receive in their match.

## Inclement Weather

In the event of inclement weather on a Tuesday, we will contact all of the players if we decide to cancel. We will try to make a decision early enough to prevent anyone from coming to the course after a cancellation. If you do not hear from us and are in doubt about the status, please call the Pro Shop at Laytonsville before coming to the course.

If we do not cancel the round and at least 70 percent of the league completes their matches, it will be considered a complete week.

Points will be awarded weekly
2 points for the winner of the match
1 point for each player in the event of a tie
0 points for a loss

Points will accumulate over the course of the season and the top 4 point getters will receive gift certificates. The amount will be determined by the number of players who sign up

The 3 players with the best net scores each week will also receive a gift card.

No player can receive more than two weekly gift cards in a row, if they do they must sit out for one week.

There will be two designated weeks for high handicappers only. You must have a 6 handicap or higher those weeks to participate in the weekly contest. I will let you know what weeks they are.

I will provide everyone with a season schedule so you can see who you will be competing against all season.
