LOCAL GOLF RULES

USGA rules of golf govern play except as modified below.

- The League Men's will play from the White Tees.
- Lift clean and place 1 club length no closer to the hole through the green (Only on greens, fringe, fairways, and primary rough)
- Scorecards must be exchanged, attested, signed, and turned in by each player. Each player is responsible for the correctness of his own hole-by-hole scoring. You must turn in your scorecard in the Proshop following your round.
- Rangefinders are permitted as long as the device is only used to determine distance.
- Pace of Play will be strictly enforced. Any groups out of place will be warned once. If a group is cited a second time, the player(s) identified to be "off pace" in the group will incur a 2 stroke penalty.
- Embedded ball rule is in effect through the green.
- All native high grass areas are played as penalty areas under rule 17.1 (player does not necessarily incur a penalty of distance and return to point of last play. Ball may be dropped using point of entry under rule 26-1)
- The ONLY "Out of Bounds" located on the course is the parking lot behind the 18th green.
- Any questions about a rule, play a second ball, hole out both shots, then ask rules committee at end of round before signing scorecard what the correct procedure should be.
- Materials piled for removal will be played as ground under repair.
